Week 2: Kingdom Characteristics

Mark 1.40-3.6

Jesus and his companions went to the town of Capernaum. When the Sabbath day came, he went into the synagogue and began to teach. Suddenly, a man in the synagogue who was possessed by an evil spirit cried out. But Jesus reprimanded him. "Be quiet! Come out of the man," he ordered.
