Daniel 3 & 4

Then King Nebuchadnezzar threw himself down before Daniel and worshiped him, and said to Daniel, "Truly, your God is the greatest of gods, the Lord over kings, a revealer of mysteries, for you have been able to reveal this secret."

King Nebuchadnezzar made a gold statue ninety feet tall and nine feet wide and set it up on the plain of Dura in the province of Babylon. Then a herald shouted out, "People of all races and nations and languages, listen to the king's command!
