

It's truly hard to believe that 2022 is just days away from coming to its conclusion. And as we end this year, I think it's wise to LOOK BACK & LOOK FORWARD. In Joshua 4, as the Israelites were preparing to cross the Jordan and enter the Promised Land they are called to place memorials at the Jordan crossing to remember what God had done. The Lord said to Moses, "choose twelve men, one from each tribe. Tell them, 'take twelve stones from...the middle of the Jordan. Carry them out and pile them up..." We will use these stones to build a memorial. In the future your child will ask, 'what do these stones mean? Then you can tell them, 'they remind us...' These stones will stand as a memorial among the people of Israel forever.

In the same way New Heights, we need to remember. We look back on and remember the faithfulness of God in the past year. We have certainly experienced a number of transitions and changes, but through it all, God has been present and constant. What is it about this past year in your life that will serve as a 'memorial stone' when you look back one year, three years, five years from now?

The leadership at New Heights sat in our first meeting of 2022 and asked the question, 'what do you want to see New Heights be and do as the year unfolds?' And although the end of 2022 looks vastly different than any of us could have imagined, I believe that we grew in the areas that we committed ourselves to, and we will continue to grow in these areas in the next year.



But as much as we want to look back, we also need to look forward to what God is planning to do in 2023. I feel like He has already given us a 'sneak peek.' This year we will conclude our Bible Engagement Project, Year 3, entitled LIVE. This is where the 'rubber meets the road' as we put everything together we have talked about for the last 2 years and seek to apply it in every way and every area of our lives.

We also continue to push beyond the walls of New Heights to meet the needs of our community. We have and continue to have conversations with organizations on how we can partner with them to help meet their needs while also fulfilling our mission. I ask that you continue to pray as the leaders seek to be faithful and proactive in doing what God has called us to do. Whether that is simply opening our building to welcome our neighbors, or creating an After School program that services children and families with quality tutoring, strong mentoring, and an overall safe space, we know that God has big things in store!

I want to close this LOOKING FORWARD & LOOKING BACK with some words from an article that I read recently. In an article on growing trends in churches under 250 in attendance, the author highlighted in his third trend that, one person can lead a dramatic and positive change in a standard church. That same article included a testimony from someone that said, 'I prayed for five visitors to come to church and ten came. I confess, I was shocked and so were the people in my small church. I have renewed zeal for what God calls me to do. I complained no one is doing anything to help our church and I heard someone say it starts with you!

In a similar way, a sermon I was listening to recently had these words that are complementary with the words from the article mentioned above. In the sermon was this little nugget: The only thing that will transform a culture is when an individual heart is transformed. What is it in this upcoming year? What is the ONE thing that you as ONE person can do that would change your heart, but also hearts around you? Whatever it is, go at it with all your might and the power and backing of the Holy Spirit! And when you look back in the last days of 2023 wouldn't you like to be able to say and see that God did what God always does?


