“The Door is Lava”

Let's make the gospel as simple as possible for others to follow.

Acts 15:16-19

‘Afterward I will return and restore the fallen house of David. I will rebuild its ruins and restore it, so that the rest of humanity might seek the Lord, including the Gentiles— all those I have called to be mine. The Lord has spoken— he who made these things known so long ago.’ “And so my judgment is that we should not make it difficult for the Gentiles who are turning to God.” NLT

Believe it or not, coming to church - as simply as it might come to you and I, can be very intimidating for folks who haven't been in awhile, or who for that matter, have never attended before. And what we need to make sure of is that we're doing everything we can to make people feel welcome, comfortable, and invited, because they are! Jesus wants everyone to be a part of his family, and so let's make sure we're inviting folks to New Heights and making them feel welcome.

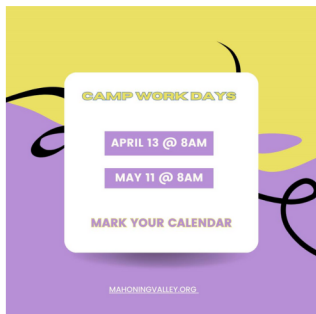
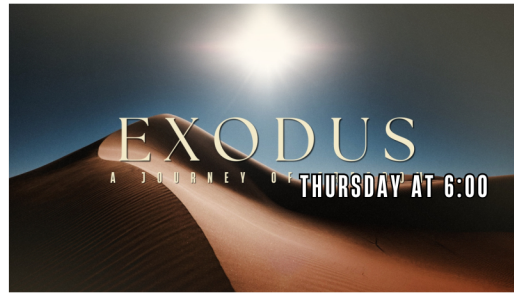
