"Lost and Found"
The Father Rejoices When His Lost Children Are Found

Luke 15:31-32

'My son,' the father said, 'you are always with me, and everything I have is yours. 32 But we had to celebrate and be glad, because this brother of yours was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.'" **NIV**

Happy Easter, Everyone! The Lord is risen! He is risen, indeed!

The disciples thought they lost Jesus. They had been present when he was arrested, and from a distance, watched as he was unfairly tortured, lifted on a cross, and eventually laid in a tomb. They thought they had seen the last of Jesus, and they hid together in a locked upper room, secretly mourning the loss of their friend, as well as the movement that might have been.

What a joy for them to learn that it didn't all end there after all! When Jesus rejoins the disciples, we read that they were celebrating and rejoicing over having their lost Lord return to them.


