### Eat My Dust!

Joshua 1:1-7

The Church Should Approach Life from a Position of Victory

#### **Joshua 1:7-8**

*"Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful." NIV*

Growing up in church, we sang a little song that I'd be willing to bet that a number of you would be familiar with - *Victory in Jesus*. A great classic hymn of the faith that, again, many of you are likely familiar with, but for those who may not be, let me share some of the lyrics:

I heard an old, old story, about a savior come from glory, how he gave his life on Calvary to save a wretch like me.

I've heard about his groaning; of his precious blood's atoning, then I repented of my sin and won the victory.

Oh, victory in Jesus! My Savior forever! He sought me and bought me with his redeeming blood.

He loved me 'ere I knew him, and all my love is due him.

He plunged me to victory beneath the cleansing flood.

The song's verses encourage the listener (and the singer) to trust that by our faith in Jesus' actions, we already have the victory over sin, over death, over... just about anything that we perceive to be standing in our way.

In Philippians 1:6, Paul tells us that he who began a good work in us will carry it through to completion. As we look at what God has called us to do, it can be intimidating. But Paul also reminds us in 2 Timothy 1:7 that we are not filled with a spirit of fear, but rather a spirit of courage, love and self-discipline. In other words, if God calls us to something, he'll equip us for it. We need only to trust that he's with us, and that he'll work through us.

Let's fight our battles from a position of victory!
