The Church's Mission Requires Unity

John 13:34-35

"So now I am giving you a new commandment: Love each other. Just as I have loved you, you should love each other. Your love for one another will prove to the world that you are my disciples." NIV

Those of you who grew up with even a small number of brothers or sisters are likely no stranger to sibling rivalries. We want space, differentiation from, and sometimes even mastery over our siblings. Why? The reasons are as varied as the siblings we battle, but one thing that all sibling rivalries have in common: they drive our parents insane!

The same is true in the church. Jesus makes it clear that if we are to be his followers - and prove to the world the same - we must get along with our siblings. It's interesting that the above quoted scripture of John 13 takes place just prior to Jesus' arrest and subsequent crucifixion.

I don't know about you, but if I knew the cross was awaiting me, that's all that would occupy my mind. And yet, here's Jesus thinking about what he wants his disciples to be doing - he wants them to love others.

I know sometimes siblings can be hard to get along with, but we have to make every effort to get along with each other; as Paul says in Colossians 3, we ought to put up with each other's faults, because the mission we've been called to work out together is far more important than any problems we might have between us.

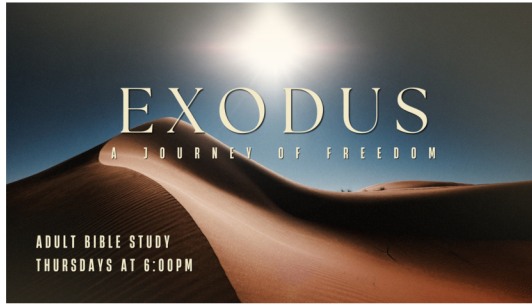

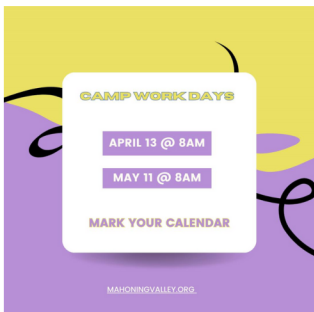
