"Forgive and Forget"

Luke 5:18-21

Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a sleeping mat. They tried to take him inside to Jesus, but they couldn't reach him because of the crowd. So, they went up to the roof and took off some tiles. Then they lowered the sick man on his mat down into the crowd, right in front of Jesus. Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the man, "Young man, your sins are forgiven." But the Pharisees and teachers of religious law said to themselves, "Who does he think he is? That's blasphemy! Only God can forgive sins!" **NLT**

While we were still sinners, Paul says, Christ died for us. Most people are unwilling to die for good people, though they may die for someone who is especially good, but, again, Paul says that God illustrates his love for us in this, that while we still sinners, Christ died for us. This is a paraphrase of Romans 5. Let me ask you something, would it be easier for you to forgive an enemy, or heal one? I think most of us would choose to spare our enemies pain, these days, but it's difficult for us to forgive them. Christ illustrates that we need to be willing to forgive our enemies no matter what. He may not need our help to forgive others, but he sure offers his help to us when we need to forgive others. We'll talk more about it this weekend. -Zach


