



“The After Picture”

Isaiah 61:1-2

The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is upon me, for the Lord has anointed me to bring good news to the poor. He has sent me to comfort the brokenhearted and to proclaim that captives will be released, and prisoners will be freed. He has sent me to tell those who mourn that the time of the Lord’s favor has come, and with it, the day of God’s anger against their enemies. NLT

Some say that Jesus’ ministry officially began when he stood in the synagogue in his hometown and read these words. He told the people in attendance that day (Luke 4:16-21) that this passage of scripture referred to him. Do you think he was right? Hard to argue with Jesus, but, did he do the four things he lists out here, during his time on earth? Did he bring good news? Comfort the broken hearted? Proclaim freedom to the captives?
