"Get in the Boat!"

Luke 5:9-11

When Simon Peter realized what had happened, he fell to his knees before Jesus and said, "Oh, Lord, please leave me—I'm such a sinful man." For he was awestruck by the number of fish they had caught, as were the others with him. His partners, James and John, the sons of Zebedee, were also amazed. Jesus replied to Simon, "Don't be afraid! From now on you'll be fishing for people!" And as soon as they landed, they left everything and followed Jesus. **NLT**

My grandparents lived in central Michigan in a cabin on a lake, meaning that summers for my brother and I were filled with swimming, skiing, and fishing. Some of you are probably pretty familiar with fishing, others are maybe not so acquainted with the hobby. It doesn't necessarily need to be a team effort, but it's nicer when it is! Grandpa would wake us up around 4:30 in the morning to get an early start while the lake was calm. I'm convinced that if I didn't have the company of he and my dad and brother, I would have fallen asleep in the boat! Back in Jesus' day, fishing was a team effort. You'd need help getting the boat to sea, help casting and pulling up the nets, and you'd certainly need help - if you had a good day - preparing the fish for dinner or for sale. Jesus calls his disciples "fishers of men." In order to properly bring in the harvest of "fish" he's got in mind for us, we're going to need to work as a team!
