I'm sure at one point in time or another, we've all been disappointed by something that we had extremely high hopes for. Whether it was a vacation you were planning, a date you were excited to go on, or a dinner that didn't taste as good as it looked, we've all had our hopes dashed by something, only to lead to us lowering our expectations in the future.

It may seem odd to think of it, but this is how the Pharisees and leaders of religious laws felt about Jesus. They were hoping for a political deliverer, someone who would route the Romans and restore Israel's autonomy. They were looking for someone who knew how hard they had been working to keep Israel on the straight and narrow, and would reward them for it, or at least value it. They were looking, basically, for someone like themselves! While they were looking for a political hero, Jesus was more content to hang out with commoners, break bread with sinners, and be ambiguous about the Sabbath. He didn't meet their expectations. I hope that he meets yours! We need to be more concerned about being like Jesus than about him being like us.

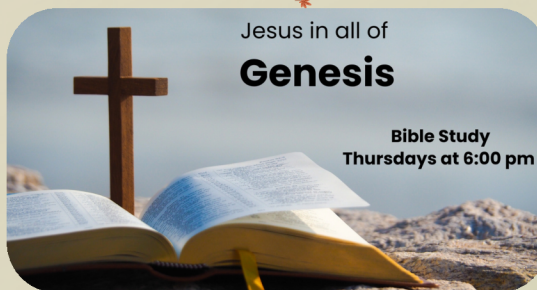
