Mark 2:27-28

Then Jesus said to them, “The Sabbath was made to meet the needs of people, and not people to meet the requirements of the Sabbath. So the Son of Man is Lord, even over the Sabbath!” NLT

I’ve heard people argue which is the more important aspect of law - the letter of it, or the heart of it? And I’ve heard that debated in many different contexts, whether biblical commands, state/local laws, or the rules of any given organization.

Typically, I err on the side of the heart of the law, rather than than the letter of the law. I’m more interested in matters of the heart than strict adherence to a code or written instruction. But when it comes to God’s law, and biblical commands, well, I want to make sure I get that right. In our sermon this week, we’ll see that Jesus needs to correct the Pharisees thinking on who the Sabbath law benefits, whether people, or the law itself.
