


# Bulletin - January 26, 2025

You know what I love about Jesus? Among other things, he has a unique ability to subvert our expectations, but in a very good way. I've made it clear that I'm a huge fan of movies - all movies, really, but I'm particularly drawn to action movies with characters that are familiar to me. One thing I've noticed in recent movies with recognizable characters is that writers will often try to surprise us with what a character does, trying to "subvert expectations" of the audience, because they think we'll naturally assume that a hero is going to try to save the day, or something like that. Thing Is, I want a hero to save the day! That's why I bought the ticket, so when he doesn't, sure, my expectations are subverted, but I'm not a happy movie-goer. Jesus, though, has a unique way of flipping the script and keeping me guessing and it's always a good thing. When he encounters a funeral procession, you might expect that he'd stop, bow his head, maybe say a few words of comfort, instead, he reaches into the coffin and pulls the deceased man back to life! That's someone worth keeping your eyes on. But why do you think Jesus does things like this? There must be a reason, right? Come join us Sunday and we'll explore that question!


