If you joined us at New Heights last week, you'll remember that we talked about the Parable of the Sower found in Luke 8. In the story, a seemingly careless Sower is tossing seed every which way; he seems ill-concerned at best about where it's falling. We made the argument that if he knew what he was doing, he'd be more careful/intentional about where he was planting. But what we realized is that the Sower is more concerned that the seed was being sown than he was about where it was landing, and from that, we reasoned that perhaps what Jesus is getting at is that he wants us to be so accustomed to sharing what he's given us that we're focused only on that - the more seed that's sown, the better the chance it has to take root. We'll take that conversation further today as we talk about this story that Jesus has given us to share. It's not for us to keep to ourselves, but we need to be sharing it. Our new sermon series is called We Need to Talk... because we do need to talk - to others, about Jesus. Let's spend some time this month getting ourselves ready to share the story, to share our faith, and hopefully, to share our place in the family with others.

We would like to invite you to be a part of this opportunity to make a difference in the lives of the children in our community.


