

New Heights "Pray without ceasing" Prayer Guide 1 Thessalonians 5:17



CHALLENGE: PERSONALIZE & PRAY THESE SCRIPTURES THROUGHOUT THE WEEK.

This Week: "An Unexpected Guest"

I will bless the Lord who guides me; even at night my heart instructs me. I know the Lord is always with me. I will not be shaken, for he is right beside me. No wonder my heart is glad, and I rejoice. My body rests in safety. For you will not leave my soul among the dead. or allow your holy one to rot in the grave. You will show me the way of life, granting me the joy of your presence and the pleasures of living with you forever. Psalm 16:7-11

Monday

Take time to read all of Luke 24 before praying.

By this time they were nearing Emmaus and the end of their journey. Jesus acted as if he were going on, but they begged him, "Stay the night with us, since it is getting late." So he went home with them. As they sat down to eat, he took the bread and blessed it. Then he broke it and gave it to them. Suddenly, their eyes were opened, and they recognized him. And at that moment he disappeared! They said to each other, "Didn't our hearts burn within us as he talked with us on the road and explained the Scriptures to us?" And within the hour they were on their way back to Jerusalem. There they found the eleven disciples and the others who had gathered with them, 34 who said, "The Lord has really risen! He appeared to Peter. Then the two from Emmaus told their story of how Jesus had appeared to them as they were walking along the road, and how they had recognized him as he was breaking the bread. Luke 24:28-35

In these passages, we observe the sadness and confusion of Jesus' followers as they traveled along the road. Their eyes were veiled by God, preventing them from recognizing Jesus. Although the living Messiah was accompanying them and sharing the living Word, they remained unaware of His presence. It was only after they welcomed Jesus to share in fellowship and break bread with them that their eyes and hearts were opened to the risen Savior. They then realized the burning desire they felt when they heard Jesus speak the living Word. The joy and excitement of their encounter propelled them to go and share with others about that they had met the Risen Savior!

Lord, I ask that my love and longing for You grows stronger each day. May the joy and excitement of being in Your presence and hearing Your Word fill my heart so completely that I cannot resist sharing it with those around me. Praise God! Jesus is our Risen Savior!

Tuesday

But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:8

Jesus, I am so grateful for your sacrifice on the cross that makes it possible for me to come into the presence of God Almighty. You bridged the gap that separated us, by covering the penalty for my sins. I thank you that I can now live and walk in peace, knowing that regardless of my circumstances on earth, I will spend eternity with you in heaven.

Wednesday

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16

Lord, this verse can often feel so familiar that it lacks power when we hear it. Please remind our hearts of the profound love you have for us—how you endured pain, humiliation, and death so that we could be reconciled with God and experience eternal life in Your presence. Thank you, Jesus!

Thursday

Since we have been united with him in his death, we will also be raised to life as he was. We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives. We are no longer slaves to sin. For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin. And since we died with Christ, we know we will also live with him. We are sure of this because Christ was raised from the dead, and he will never die again. Death no longer has any power over him. When he died, he died once to break the power of sin. But now that he lives, he lives for the glory of God. So you also should consider yourselves to be dead to the power of sin and alive to God through Christ Jesus.

Jesus, You are my Protector and my Redeemer! You went to the cross to conquer sin and death for me and for all humanity! You rose to life and sit at the right hand of God Almighty!

Thank you for freeing me from the power of sin in my life. Thank you for making me alive to God, now and for all eternity!

Jesus, help me to never take this gift of mercy and grace for granted. Grant me the strength, courage, and wisdom to live out Your word every day, and to share the Good News of the Gospel through my words and actions daily.

Romans 10:9-13

Friday

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved. As the Scriptures tell us, "Anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced." Jew and Gentile are the same in this respect. They have the same Lord, who gives generously to all who call on him. For "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

Lord, I humbly proclaim that you are Lord! You have been resurrected from the dead and now sit at the right hand of God. It is only through you that I possess the hope and promise of eternal life.

I lift up those in my life that have yet to embrace this truth. I pray that their hearts and minds will be opened to hearing and believing the transformative message of the Gospel. I pray that you will give them a new heart and put a new spirit in them. Remove their stubborn, hardened hearts and give them tender, responsive hearts that are eager to understand Your Word and accept the gracious gift of salvation that You so mercifully and generously extend to them.

Let me never cease in praying for those who do not know you as their Lord and Savior.

Saturday

For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. Jeremiah 29:11

Lord, this reminds me of the saying, "Man plans, and God laughs." We often display arrogance when we create our own plans without seeking Your guidance, especially knowing that Your intentions for us are filled with goodness and hope beyond our wildest dreams. Instill in our hearts a longing for Your will above everything else. Let Your kingdom come, and may Your will be done in my life, and on earth as it is in heaven.

It's in Jesus' name we pray. Amen!

Memorize Scripture With Us

Recite or write down this verse three times a day for seven days. Let's commit to hiding God's Word in our hearts together.

And may you have the power to understand, as all God's people should, how wide, how long, how high, and how deep his love is. May you experience the love of Christ, though it is too great to understand fully. Then you will be made complete with all the fullness of life and power that comes from God. Now all glory to God, who is able, through his mighty power at work within us, to accomplish infinitely more than we might ask or think. Glory to him in the church and in Christ Jesus through all generations forever and ever! Amen. Ephesians 3:18-21
