Growing up, we had a plaque on the wall of mom and dad’s house that I believe is actually still hanging prominently on the wall. It contains Matthew’s version of the text of the Lord’s Prayer. It’s probably the first scripture that I memorized, and that was on purpose - this scripture shows us how to most effectively communicate with God. That this is how Jesus teaches us to pray means that we should be paying close attention to the words and what they teach us about how to communicate with our Heavenly Father.

I also think it’s worth noting that this is the only time in all of scripture that the apostles ask Jesus to teach them something. Not that this is the only place where he does teach them, but it’s the only place we see them asking to be taught about a specific subject, which means the apostles - who started the kingdom we’re currently building - wanted to make sure they knew how to effectively communicate with the Father. If it’s important to the ones who started the work, I think we can safely assume it’s important to those of us who are continuing that work as well.

NHCC Prayer Guide

This week's key scripture from the sermon: **Matthew 6:6**

Take time each day to:

- **Read The Word**
 - Pick one of the passages to focus on for the day.
- **Meditate on The Word**
 - Read the passage slowly and repeatedly.
 - Allow your heart to be moved and guided by the Spirit as you engage with the scripture.
 - Use these reflections as a bridge. Connect your study of the Word with your prayers, allowing your thoughts and insights to deepen your conversation with the Lord.
- **PRAY - Praise, Repent, Ask, Yield**

Read The Word - "One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When he finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray, just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say:

"Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread. Forgive us our sins, for we also forgive everyone who sins against us. And lead us not into temptation."

Meditate on The Word:

Father, may your name forever be honored as Holy.

Thank you for the privilege you have given me, through Jesus Christ, to bow my heart before you in prayer. May I always come to You with a humble heart, recognizing that you are the one and only King. I praise you as King of *my heart* and *my life*.

I lift up my New Heights family to you in prayer and ask that each one of us will seek a real and intimate relationship with You.

A relationship that is not shallow but runs deep and overflows from our hearts and our lives, allowing us to pour into the lives of those around us.

I pray that you will teach us to depend on you for everything we need. Deepen our trust in you, Father, to provide the things that are best for us, even when we can't see it or understand what you are doing.

Lord, when we are doubting or worrying in our circumstances, I pray that you will remind us that You have a plan for each of us that is better than anything we could ever ask or imagine.
