

As we draw closer to Easter Sunday and enter a time of reflection and gratitude for what Jesus did on the cross in purchasing our redemption and making reconciliation possible with the Father through his blood, I would like to challenge us as a church to consider the last words of Jesus as he hung on the cross. You can tell an awful lot about a person in the last words they choose to say. It sort of sums up their lives and what they believed in, stood for, etc. In Jesus' case, this is especially true, though, to be fair, they weren't his last words, were they? What since he rose again and all... Still, I would invite us to consider the meaning of Jesus' final statements before completing his first coming to Earth. In his first statement as he hung on the cross, he asks the Father to forgive the people who put him there, because they didn't realize what they were doing. Is your first impulse to forgive someone when they've wronged you? I'll be honest, that's usually not the first thing that comes to mind for me, but that it does for Jesus means that those of us who follow him should probably spend a little bit of time talking about what that means, and what it means for us as his followers. Come by Sunday and we'll try to sort it out together.


