



Ephesians 6:10-11

Finally, be strong in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the full armor of God, so that you can take your stand against the devil's schemes. NIV

I think it's kind of funny that Paul likens truth (in Ephesians 6:14) to a belt that a soldier wears. Think for a minute about the job of a belt; what do we use a belt for? The simple answer? To keep our trousers from falling down, right? There are other functions, too. They might be useful for clipping a cell phone, or a soldier might strap his sword to it; in other cases it might enhance the style or fashion of the person wearing it, but a belt's basic job is to keep our trousers up. I guess what I take that to mean then, is that what Paul is saying is that a person who can't discern truth from fiction is like a fool who can't even keep his trousers from falling down. Think of the cartoons or movies you've watched over the years where a fella's trousers fall... you're probably thinking of something like Elmer Fudd or *The Three Stooges* or something like that. Conversely, someone who's never had his belt fail on him? Batman. That's right, Adam West himself would never be caught without his utility belt strapped firmly in place. Think for a second about the difference between the characters. Elmer Fudd is clueless, hapless individual who wears suspenders, and whose characterized by his ability to be fooled or tricked by an anthropomorphic rabbit. Batman, on the other hand, utility belt firmly in place, has a plan to take down the scariest scumball and vilest of villains that dare to bedevil his beloved Gotham City. Batman not only knows the truth, but he illustrates what it looks like to be guided by it. He's always prepared, always vigilant, and always ready to topple truthless tyrants who try to tackle Gotham. So, in short, don't be a suspender-wearing "Fudd"-y duddy who can't even manage to keep his trousers up. Be like Batman - knowing the truth and being ready at a moment's notice to defend it.
